About Lathbury Manor

Lathbury Manor is a 27-bedroom (25 single and 2 double occupancy) residential care home that provides long-term residential care, respite care and day care for older people with a wide range of needs for care and support with their daily lives.



All of our residents have bespoke rooms, each with their own character and adapted to meet each resident's needs. The home has beautiful secure gardens, and a separate activity centre/tearoom in the gardens. This is used by residents and their families when visiting, and for parties to celebrate special events such as birthdays.

The home is staffed by a team of well qualified and experienced care staff. Our care staff assist our residents with washing and dressing, eating, and drinking, mobilising, socialising, and meeting all their daily living requirements.





Life at Lathbury Manor

Here at Lathbury our residents' happiness is our priority. We pride ourselves in the person-centred care we deliver, as we make sure our residents see Lathbury as their home. We strive to make it as homely as possible, and a safe, sociable, and comfortable place to live. We put a strong emphasis on social activity, and staying connected with our residents' families and the community.

We encourage open visiting, family meals and parties, and visits to and from the local community. We have a full programme of social activities in and outside the home, supported by a dedicated activity coordinator to make sure all this happens to the satisfaction of our residents.

As a smaller home we can generate a real sense of community and encourage our families to give us regular feedback through family meetings, surveys, an open office, and direct contact with the owners through phone and email. Anyone who stays with us sees Lathbury Manor as their home.



Special memories

We strive to make every day at Lathbury Manor special, whether it is a visit from one of our regular entertainers, one of our seasonal parties or our regular programme of daily activities. Our carers, family members, visiting professionals and volunteers work together to ensure our residents continue to lead a meaningful and fulfilling life.

Excellent care

Our dedicated team of staff are all trained as a minimum to diploma in care level 2 and additionally in working with people with dementia. Every day we have a carer on duty dedicated to running a full programme of recreational and occupational activities. We are visited on a regular basis by the full range of healthcare professionals, to help us meet each individual's healthcare needs.

Residential care

Our care staff assist our residents with washing and dressing, eating and drinking, mobilising, socialising, and meeting all their daily living requirements. The home looks after residents with:

- Dementia
- Strokes
- Parkinson's disease
- Multiple Sclerosis
- Older adults with learning disabilities
- Older adults with acquired brain injuries
- General frailty associated with old age, often with a significant risk of falls and injury.

Day care

Lathbury Manor can provide day care to residents who need the support of our staff during the day but are able to be looked after at home by their family or home carers at night.

Respite care

Lathbury Manor can offer respite care when bed availability allows. Our minimum respite care period is one week.


